There are hikes in Wasdale that range from gentle strolls to climbing England's highest peak, Scafell Pike. This map shows easy walks connecting Nether Wasdale village with the lake shore for that famous view up the valley, ideal if you are parking or staying in the village.

- Do I know what the **weather** will be like?

Wasdale is a very special place, much of the valley including the verges at the Lake Shore is a SSSI, which means it has special protection due to its unique plants and wildlife. It is also farmed in the traditional way with sheep both in the fields and on the fells.

Please follow the Country Code and visit kindly:

- Camp and motorhome only in official sites
- Do not light fires or barbecues
- Take all your litter home
- Keep your dog under close control at all times, on a lead near sheep, and pick up and bin its waste
- Park in car parks, not on verges or blocking roads and gateways
- Travel sustainably and leave no trace

The Wasdale Shuttle will make your visit to Wasdale easier for you and better for the climate, the community and the landscape.

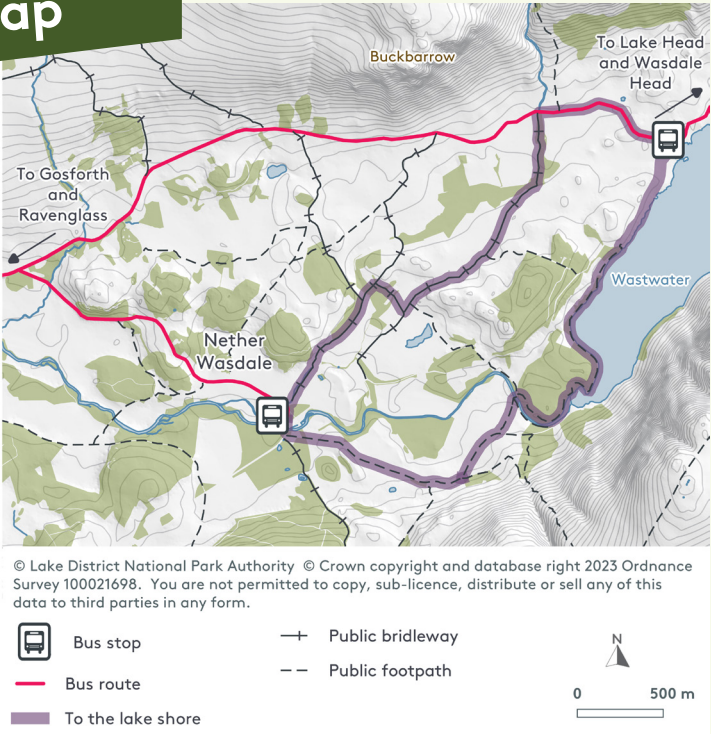
Parking in the valley is limited, but at peak times you can park in the pop-up car park in Nether Wasdale and catch the bus to Wasdale Head
