The Lake District is the perfect place to explore dramatic landscapes, reconnect with nature and uncover fascinating history. Alongside England's highest mountain, Scafell Pike, and its deepest lake, Wastwater, some of the area's most distinctive houses, gardens and historical sites are looked after by the National Trust and open for you to enjoy.

With opportunities for mountain biking, paddleboarding and fell climbing, National Trust places provide days of adventure for any outdoor enthusiast. Discover miles of waymarked trails and woodland at Wray (F9) on Windermere's western shoreline, hire a rowing boat to get out on the water at Fell Foot (F10), and experience the thundering power of a 65-foot waterfall at Aira Force (F7).

Literary fans can draw inspiration from the homes of Beatrix Potter and William Wordsworth at Hill Top (F9) and Allan Bank (E8) respectively, while keen gardeners can call in at Sizergh (G10) and Wordsworth House & Garden (C6) for ideas to take home. Seasonal events and activities take place year-round, and many places are dog-friendly with a café. National Trust members enjoy free entry and parking.
