

DOGGY ETIQUETTE

Be especially vigilant around livestock. Just be aware, it is an offence to allow your pet to bother any livestock. Please keep your dog on a lead and give farm animals plenty of space not to feel intimidated. Cows on the other hand may be more curious, but should they charge toward you, drop your dog lead and run to safety. Your pet will be able to outrun any danger by itself.

Protect our beautiful wildlife. To protect the local wildlife but also your pet, it's important that wildlife should not become distressed. Please keep your dog on a lead and respect any official signage restricting access should you come across them.

Protect against animal and insect bites. Long grass can often be home to insects, parasites and even adders, so please be vigilant. If your pet is bitten by an adder, try not to let it move and consult a vet as soon as possible.

Pick up after your pooch. Always ensure you carry sufficient waste bags during your explorations and that you dispose of any plastic bags in appropriately labelled bins.

Respect other visitors. As much as we love our four-legged friends, please respect other walkers, cyclists and horse riders by keeping dogs under close control.
